Katherine Kaufer Christoffel is a professor of Pediatrics and Preventive Medicine at Northwestern University's Feinberg School of Medicine, and an attending pediatrician at Children's Memorial Hospital in Chicago. She received her BA in philosophy from Radcliffe College, her MD from Tufts University, and her MPH from Northwestern University. Dr. Christoffel is a nationally respected researcher and the recipient of professional awards from the American Academy of Pediatrics, the American Public Health Association, and other national groups. She founded the Children's Memorial Hospital Nutrition Evaluation Clinic and has a longstanding interest in obesity prevention. At Children's Memorial Hospital in Chicago, Dr. Christoffel serves as the Director of the Center for Obesity Management and Prevention (COMP) and as the Medical and Research Director of CLOCC.
